MUSICAL THEATRE GUILD'S DOT PASQUALICHIO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- A. The scholarship applicant must:
 - 1. Be a senior at or a graduate of an accredited high school.
 - 2. Have participated in at least one Musical Theatre Guild production in any capacity.
 - 3. Have a high school grade point average of at least 3.0 (B average).
 - 4. Be accepted for and registered in an accredited college or theatre school. Preference may be given to a student registered in a theatre arts, vocal or music program of study.
 - 5. Complete the MTG scholarship award application.
- B. Financial need shall not be a consideration.
- C. Recommendation for the award shall be made by a committee consisting of the president, one board member, and one educator.
- D. The award will be granted by the Musical Theatre Guild Board of Directors and need not be awarded each year.
- E. The amount of the award or qualifications can be changed at any time by vote of the Musical Theatre Guild Board of Directors.
